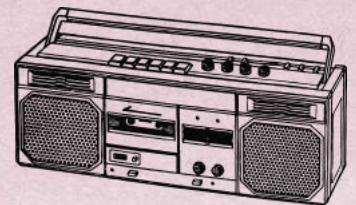

REMAINING SAFE WHILST NAVIGATING DISNEY+

5 TOP TIPS FOR PARENTS DISNEY+

- 1 Create a strong username & password**
On its release in the US, Canada and Mexico in November 2019, Disney+ was designed by a plethora of tech geeks. They spent considerable time and effort to ensure that their service and content were secure. To date, Disney+ has confirmed that no data breach has taken place. As Disney+ doesn't use 2-factor authentication, anybody who possibly has your username and password could also access your credit card details. Therefore, it's important to create a strong username and a Disney password that isn't used for other sites. Always use a mixture of letters (upper and lowercase), numbers and symbols and try to create the maximum length of characters.
- 2 Monitor your child's usage**
While the ability to stream on almost any device capable of connecting to the internet might seem great for your family, it also means that your child can access content from anywhere. Parental controls on Disney+ are quite limited and there are no restrictions on what your child can watch. It can be easy for children to binge watch, particularly given the amount of content available. Apps, Google Play, Amazon, and other app stores all have parental controls. Disney+ also has a number of parental controls to help you manage how long their child uses the app.
- 3 Enable 'Kid's Profile' mode**
Although Disney+ is designed to be family friendly and offers a wide range of content, it's important to ensure that children can only access content that is appropriate for their age. Disney+ has a 'Kid's Profile' mode which allows you to create a profile for your child and restrict their access to content that is appropriate for their age. This is a great feature for parents and children to use as it allows you to manage their viewing experience.
- 4 Double check for films with outdated cultural depictions**
The Disney+ content includes programmes that go back to the 1930s and which contain depictions of people from different cultures and backgrounds. This is a great feature for parents and children to use as it allows you to manage their viewing experience.
- 5 Sit back and enjoy!**
Now that you've taken all the necessary steps to ensure your child's safety, you can sit back and enjoy Disney+. The service is designed to be family friendly and offers a wide range of content that is appropriate for all ages.
