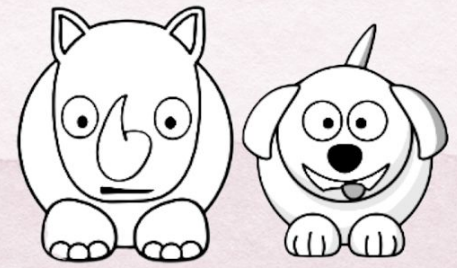


## WATER BOTTLES
