# MRS SELANT'S SHORTBREAD RECIPE



Combine all ingredients in a mixing bowl and make into a dough. If the mixture is too soft to roll, then put it into the fridge to stiffen up.

On a floured surface, roll out the dough and cut with any shaped cutter you have.

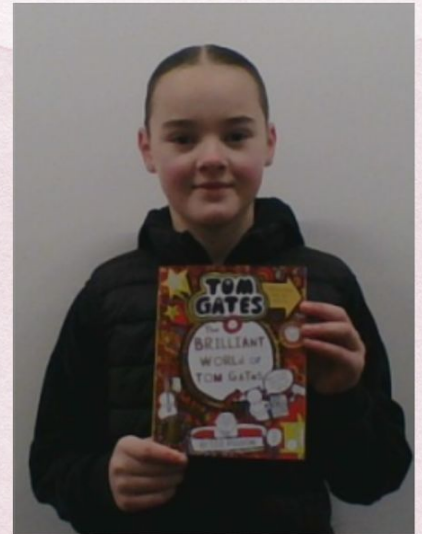

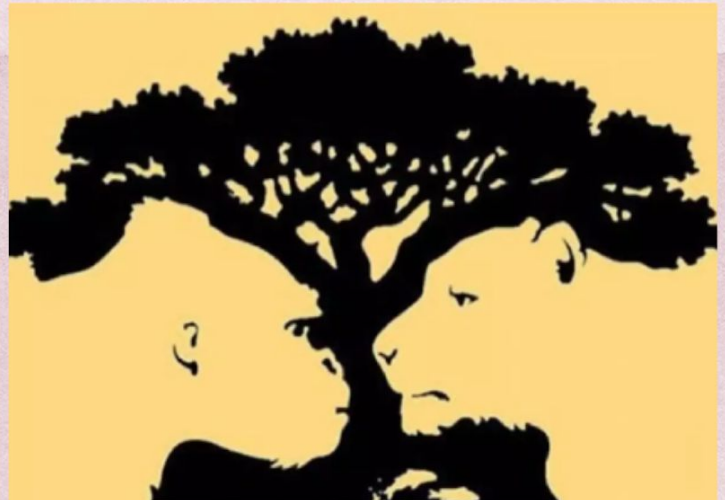
